5 Ways To Pray The Holy Rosary With Devotion

Pray the rosary daily privately or with friends and family.
Pray the rosary during the day—try not to postpone it until the end of the day or bedtime.
If possible, use a book, an App or an audio recording of the Rosary to help you enter more deeply into each mystery, and with young children, use a booklet or app that shows an image for each mystery of the rosary.
When you see an image of our Lady, at home, on the street, in Church, direct a glance at it and send her an affectionate interior prayer or greeting.
Make a pilgrimage to a nearby church or shrine dedicated to Mary.
